Australia's anticipated World Record-Breaking Land Speed Car is Complete

Aussie Invader 5R now ready for fuel and engine testing

(Perth) Rosco McGlashan OAM, driver of the Aussie Invader 5R, announced today August 1st, 2018 that after nine years of engineering and building, his car is now completed.

The car will be capable of travelling above the speed of sound at Mach 1.4, or over 1,000mph (1,600km) in order to set a new supersonic land speed record.

The vehicle build completes Stage 1 of a 3 Stage project, which now moves to static engine ground tests in California's Mojave Desert.

Rosco McGlashan said, "Successful tests of this engine will see us leap ahead with my team's ambitions to build and drive the 'World's Fastest Car'."

This record-breaking event is on schedule for 2020. A new fundraising campaign has been launched #gosupersonic, where people can upload their selfies starting at \$20 AUD which will then be affixed to the outside of the car for the record-breaking runs and future promotions.
